Description of Field:

The animal science field encompasses many different aspects of animal studies.

Government agencies have animal related sectors that focus on research and laboratory work, environmental regulation, livestock specialties. There are also professional careers, such as veterinary medicine, that focus on the care and wellbeing of animals. Animal sciences can also be essential to education for training or research purposes.

Animal caretakers are also a large portion of the animal science field, which can be found in zoos, kennels, clinics, and farms.

The animal sciences field is constantly changing and an important function of the co-existence of humans and animals.
